

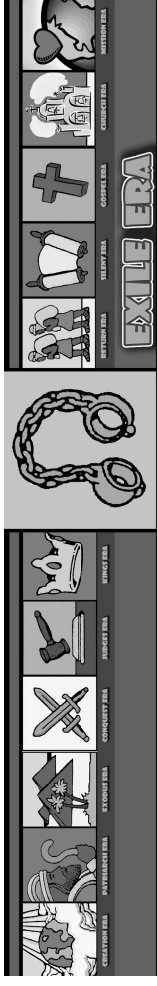
Abraham's family called Israel, becomes slaves in Egypt, so God sent Moses to lead them out and gives them his laws.
